Abby is 4 years old. Her favorite color is pink and she loves princesses. She was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL) on February 16, 2011. She began treatment immediately because she was classified as high risk. On February 25, 2011 she was further diagnosed with the Philadelphia Chromosome Positive. Regular chemotherapy is not as effective with this type of disease. She is now in need of a bone marrow transplant.



Carrie is a 34 year old devoted mother of 3 young children and Air Force wife. Her husband and family are currently stationed at Eglin AFB. In late 2010 she became suddenly and critically ill while attending a festival at her kid's elementary school. Carrie was subsequently diagnosed with a rare blood disease called hemophagocytic lymphohistiocytosis and started a long course of treatment with chemotherapy. In October of 2011, Carrie experienced a significant setback and is now in need of a bone marrow transplant.
